#### 7. Change of School Uniform vendor

A new uniform vendor has been contracted to provide school uniform and PE attire to De La Salle School with effect from 1 April 2024. The new vendor is Jeep Sing Fashion (4012 Ang Mo Kio Ave 10 #01-09 Techplace 1 Singapore 569628).

Our new PE attire is designed with our school colours (green and white), as adopted by fellow La Salle schools. In view of the changing climate, the material of the PE Tshirt has been enhanced to provide a more comfortable feel and easy laundering. The PE shorts will be an inch longer to provide more comfort to our Lasallians.





The new PE attire and will be in stock from May 2024 onwards. However, our Lasallians can continue to wear their current PE attire till end 2024. The school will transit to the new PE attire in 2025 for P1 to P5 Lasallians. P6 (2025) Lasallians will have the option to remain using their current PE attire. The sale of uniforms will be made available in school in November and December 2024 (exact sale dates will be shared later).
