1. Resumption of Wearing of School Uniform

2. 2024 Parent-Teacher Meeting 1

Please remind your child/ward to check if he/she is able to log into the SLS portal at least 2 days prior to HBL Day through https://learning.moe.edu.sg. If your child/ward has forgotten his/her password, please do a self-reset or visit our school website (https://www.delasalle.moe.edu.sg/for-parents/hbl/), to do a reset.
