This competition started in 2018 as one of SOTA's Outreach Programmes to encourage and provide a platform for young artists to express their creativity and hone their talents in Visual Arts. The theme of Olivia's artwork is "My Future World" which gives audience a glimpse into what she envisions the world will be like in the coming years.

3. CCA Experience Week 2022

To help our Primary 3 Lasallians make an informed choice in their CCA selection and to have an opportunity to discover the different CCA learning experiences, our CCA teachers have come together to plan a "CCA EX³ WEEK - Exposure, Experience, Excite!" in the week beginning 9 May 2022.

a. 7 of our CCA groups (Modern Dance, Cultural Dance, Percussion, Choir, Hockey, Wushu & Talking Titans) will be putting up an assembly showcase on Mon, 9 May

2022 in the Multi-Purpose Hall. With a combination of CCA videos + live demonstrations + sharing of CCA experiences by Primary 5 Lasallians, we hope that this will provide the **EXPOSURE** for our Primary 3 Lasallians to glean some of the precious learning points through CCA participation. Our Primary 2 Lasallians will join the Primary 3 Lasallians in this assembly showcase.

- b. For the entire week, another 7 CCA groups (Netball, Basketball, Chess Club, Scouts, Brownies, Robotics & Rugby) will take turns to set up activity stations during the Primary 3 recess. These CCAs are best experienced through hands-on activities and we hope that these mini stations will allow our Primary 3 Lasallians to **EXPERIENCE** some elements of learning within that particular CCA and discover their interests through these experiences.
- c. Our McNally Club and Media Club members will also be putting up a mini exhibition at the Artscape area for the whole week; showcasing some of their fabulous artwork and photography work. Discovery Club has also taken the time to prepare a simple activity pack for all Primary 3 Lasallians to try out at home, guided by instructions in a SLS package.

Through participation in all these activities, we hope that this will **EXCITE** them to find out more of what CCA @DLS has to offer; and how CCA can be a platform for them to discover their talents, stretch their potential and forge strong friendships.

4. Travel Declaration for Mid-Year School Holidays

The mid-year school holidays will commence from 28 May to 26 June 2022. School will reopen in Term 3 on Monday, 27 June 2022. We wish all Lasallians a good mid-year break.

To make a travel declaration for your child/ward via Parents' Gateway (PG), go to [SERVICE > DECLARE TRAVELS].

For travel during mid-year holiday, please declare your child/ward's travel plan(s), indicating both the country and city of travel, and any city of transit, by 27 May 2022 (Friday). Only one parent is required to declare.

If your child/ward is **not travelling** during the holidays, **no action is required** on your side.

If there is a change of travel plan(s) after declaration, please submit a new travel declaration for the updated travel destination via PG or inform the school for cancellation of travel plan(s).

5. School Holidays Crime Prevention Advisory

The Singapore Police Force would like to share some steps with parents/guardians for you to keep our Lasallians and loved ones safe from being victims of Voyeurism or Molestation during the upcoming mid-year school holidays.

Lasallians may take the following precautions:

- Be alert and attentive to your surroundings especially when you are in a crowded and confined space.
- If someone moves very close to you (e.g. someone deliberately stands or sits close to you in a bus or MRT), move away if possible.
- Avoid going out at night alone. If you have to, go out in a group or get someone (parent, close friend) to accompany you.
- Avoid wandering around alone, be wary and move away from strangers who try to get close to you.

The Choa Chu Kang Neighbourhood Police Centre (CKNPC) provides a free alert service to residents via the Community Alert Service (CAS) and CKNPC Facebook page.

- 2. Intent of the video <u>must</u> demonstrate the theme "Passing on the Passion" and Appreciation of Teachers.
 - Examples will include performance, short stories of appreciation of their teachers, reciting of poems, drawings, works of art, singing of the Anniversary song "Our Mission never ends" https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Cl6ukQtldBs
- 3. Acceptable medium will include Video Recording, TikTok, Instareel, etc.
- 4. Lasallians are allowed to form their own groups among themselves.
- 5. Parents and Lasallians are highly encouraged to take part together!

Kindly note that the Teachers' Day committee will only do a review and shortlisting of video performances from June to end July 2022, so parents' commitment to help is crucial and much appreciated.
