Principal's Note

Dear Parents,

With the removal of mid-year exams for all levels, the usual time required for preparation and marking of exams has now been used for more time to explore the joy of learning and provide authentic learning experiences for our Lasallians across the year. Our P5 English Language teachers took the opportunity to wrap up term one through a visit by Singapore's very own legendary sprinter, Mr C Kunalan.

The visit was based on the P5 STELLAR Unit: Late But Not Last – An Interview with C Kunalan. Mr Kunalan spoke to our Lasallians and regaled them with a vivid and honest account of his experiences training as a sprinter to represent Singapore in various international competitions including the Olympics. Our Primary 5 Lasallians were given the opportunity to ask questions which he graciously answered with motivating messages and inspiring anecdotes.

A second series of interviews were with three sports stars who have represented Singapore in international tournaments in various sporting fields who are now serving as coaches: Coach Syasya (Hockey), Coach Ridhwan (Boxing), Coach Suhaimi (Rugby). The coaches not only answered the questions posed by our Lasallians, but also willingly shared their life lessons, their struggles and successes during their conversations.
