2. Online Order (Home Delivery) of School Uniform

In view of the current hot and humid weather, School will continue with the current practice to allow Lasallians to wear PE attire until further notice. This will supersede the March 2023 Parent Notification on the reinstatement of the pre-COVID code for wearing of school uniform from Term 3 Semester 2. We will consider the reinstatement at a future date.

3. Founder's Day cum Primary 3 to Primary 5 (2022) Prize-Giving Day

School will be commemorating our Founder's Day on Monday 15 May 2023 from 7.30 am to 10.30 am. School hours will be curtailed at 10.30 am. A series of learning activities has been planned to enable our Lasallians to learn about the life of our Founder and how as a Lasallian Community, the school can continue his mission to serve.

Parents are to notify Form Teachers or school bus operators/external student care centre operators in advance of any changes in usual school dismissal arrangements due to the curtailed school hours.

Following school dismissal, only the award recipients for the Primary 3 to Primary 5 (2022) Prize Giving Ceremony will remain in school together with their parents for the ceremony from 11.30 am to 1 pm.

4. Travel Declaration for Mid-Year School Holidays

The mid-year school holidays will commence from 29 May to 25 June 2023. School will reopen in Term 3 on Monday, 26 June 2023. We wish all Lasallians a good mid-year break.

To ensure schools continue to be a healthy and safe environment for all, we require parents/guardians to make a travel declaration for your child/ward only if he/she intends to travel overseas for the holidays.

To make a travel declaration for your child/ward via Parents' Gateway (PG), go to [SERVICE > DECLARE TRAVELS].

• For travel during mid-year holiday, please declare your child/ward's travel plan(s), indicating both the country and city of travel, and any city of transit, by 26 May 2023 (Friday). Only one parent is required to declare.

If your child/ward is **not travelling** during the holidays, **no action is required** on your side.

If there is a change of travel plan(s) after declaration, please submit a new travel declaration for the updated travel destination via PG or inform the school for cancellation of travel plan(s).

5. School Holidays Crime Prevention Advisory

The Singapore Police Force would like to share some steps with parents/guardians for you to keep our Lasallians and loved ones safe from being victims of Voyeurism or Molestation during the upcoming mid-year school holidays.

Lasallians may take the following precautions:

- Be alert and attentive to your surroundings especially when you are in a crowded and confined space.
- If someone moves very close to you (for example, someone deliberately stands or sits close to you in a bus or MRT), move away if possible.
- Avoid going out at night alone. If you need to, go out in a group or get someone (parent, close friend) to accompany you.
- Avoid wandering around alone, be wary and move away from strangers who try to get close to you.

Guidelines for submission:

- 1. Keep strictly to a maximum of 3 minutes of performance time.
- 2. Each group must have a minimum of 5 students.
- 3. Lasallians are encouraged to form their own groups among themselves, preferably within the same level or among family members. They can also form groups among the same recess level (i.e. P1/P5, P2/P6, P3/P4) so as to facilitate practices should their group be shortlisted for the actual concert.
- 4. Examples will include dance performances, musical instruments, short stories of appreciation of their teachers or reciting of poems.
- 5. Intent of the video <u>must</u> demonstrate the theme "Our Dream & Way Forward" and Appreciation of Teachers.

Kindly note that the Teachers' Day committee will only be able to assist with a few practice sessions for the shortlisted groups from July to August 2023, so parents' commitment to help is crucial and much appreciated.
