1. Parent-Teacher Meeting 2026 (via Microsoft Teams)

The Parent-Teacher Meeting (PTM) scheduled on 9 and 10 April 2026 serves to provide a platform for teachers and parents to discuss our Lasallians' holistic development. This is also an opportunity for us to work together to set realistic goals together with our Lasallians whilst building a stronger home-school partnership to support their growth. You may refer to the PG sent on 10 March 2026 and 16 March 2026 for more information.

Please note that it is a **no-school day on 10 April 2026**, and thus Lasallians will be engaged in Home-Based Learning activities.

The Ministry of Education (MOE) has refreshed the Guidelines for School-Home Partnership (Annex 1) to support parents and teachers with the goal to raise a happy, confident and kind generation together. MOE has also launched a parenting-focused Instagram account, **@parentingwith.moeg**, to connect and support parents by sharing tips and resources.

2. Commemoration of International Friendship Day 2026

The school will be commemorating International Friendship Day on Monday, 13 April 2026. The theme, *'Singapore: Forging Friendships in a Complex World'*, aims to foster an appreciation of different cultures and perspectives, so that Lasallians will be better equipped to contribute to a cohesive and globally connected society. We hope to nurture in our Lasallians the spirit of friendship and collaboration among different peoples in ASEAN and beyond. Fun-filled activities will also be conducted during recess. The school would like to take this opportunity to thank our Parent Support Group (PSG) members for rendering their support to our teachers for the event.

3. Physical Fitness Test (PFT) for Primary 4 and Primary 6 Lasallians

The PFT for Primary 4 and Primary 6 Lasallians will start on the 20 April 2026. Our PE teachers have started preparing our Lasallians for the PFT during their PE lessons since Term 1. The 5-station test includes sit-ups, inclined pull-ups, standing broad jump, sit and reach, as well as the shuttle run. Lasallians are allowed to bring their running shoes (stored in a shoe bag) to change into before taking the 5-station test and the 1.6km run.

Primary 4 and Primary 6 students will be notified of their 5-station and 1.6km test dates by their PE teachers. The school will monitor the weather situation and remind Lasallians to have regular water breaks.

Those with underlying medical conditions or who are on long-term medical leave and are seeking exemption from the test should provide a doctor's letter.

4. Class Photo-taking 2026

The school will be conducting the yearly class photo-taking exercise for all Lasallians from Primary 1 to Primary 6 during curriculum time. The scheduled dates for this photo-taking exercise are Monday, 20 April and Tuesday, 21 April 2026. All Lasallians are to wear their full school uniform (with tie) for this photo-taking session.

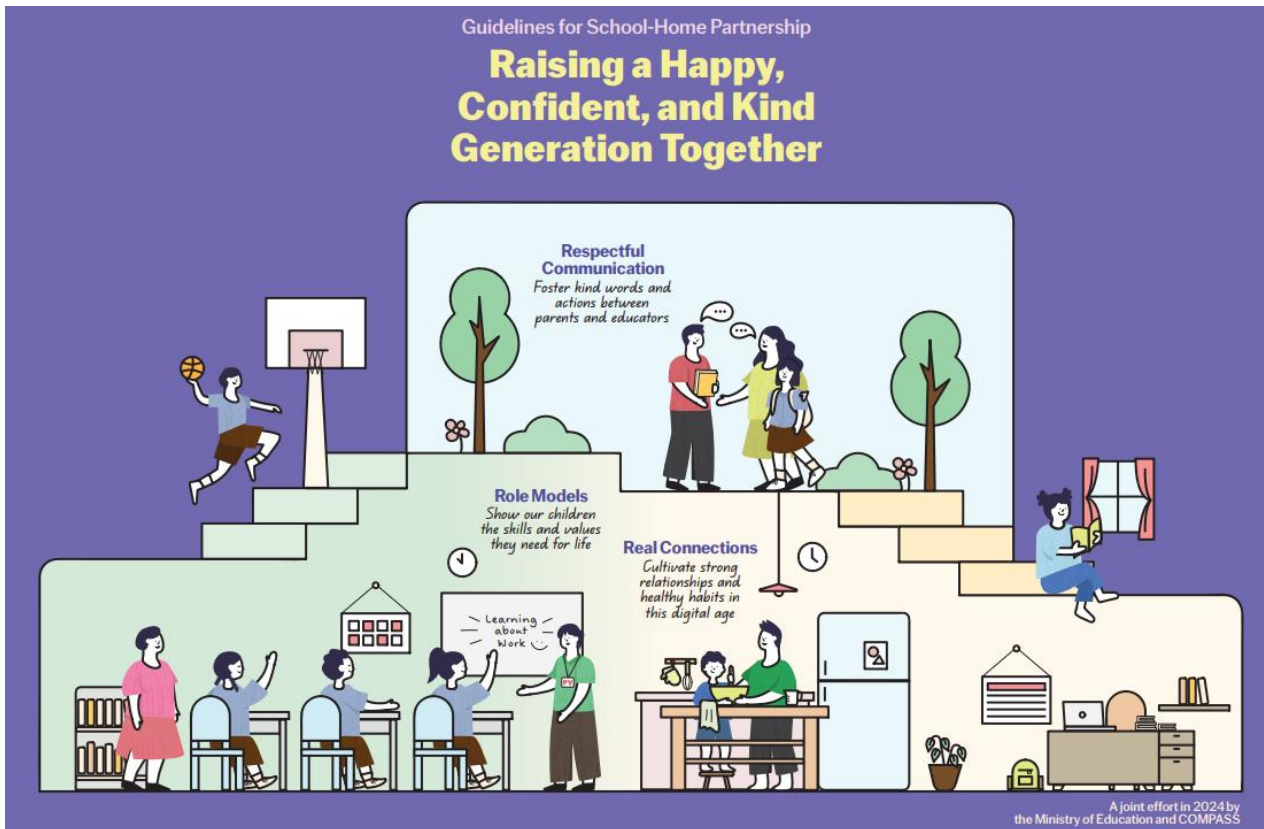
5. Earth Week 2026

The theme for Earth Day 2026 is "*Our Power, Our Planet*" which highlights the importance of taking actions for a sustainable future. To bring this to life, Lasallians will participate in hands-on activities from 27 April 2026 to 30 April 2026, with a focus on biodiversity and marine conservation. Through these experiences, we hope to nurture environmentally conscious and responsible Lasallians who actively champion sustainability efforts whilst exemplifying our core values of Faith, Service, and Community. Our Lasallians will not only contribute to a sustainable planet but also develop Enhanced 21st Century Competencies (E21CC) such as civic literacy, collaborative learning, problem solving and critical thinking.

There will be a hands-on parent-child workshop organised for Primary 1 and Primary 2 on Tuesday, 5 May 2026. This workshop helps parent and child create innovative toys, in preparation for the participation in Sony Creative Science Award 2026.
