2. Primary 3 CCA Experience Day, 7 May 2026

Our Primary Three Lasallians will be embarking on their Co-Curricular Activities (CCA) journey in Semester 2. During the Experience Day, CCA teachers and CCA leaders will facilitate a variety of engaging, hands-on activities to give students a taste of what each CCA offers. Each Primary Three Lasallian will get to experience 4 different CCAs of their choice, helping them discover their preferences and areas of interest. After the CCA Experience Day, we encourage parents/guardians to speak with your child about what they enjoyed and which CCA they feel most excited to join. Do support and respect your child's choice, as this marks the beginning of a meaningful and enjoyable CCA journey.

3. Founder's Day cum Primary 3 to Primary 5 (2025) Prize-Giving Day, 15 May 2026

We will be celebrating Founders Day on **Friday, 15 May 2026** with a special programme for all Lasallians to appreciate the story and journey of our Founder, St John Baptist De la Salle. School hours will be from **7.30 a.m to 10.30 a.m.**

Primary 1 and Primary 2 Lasallians will be dismissed at 10.20 a.m. Following school dismissal at 10.30 am, only recipients for the Primary 3 to Primary 5 (2025) awards and performers for Prize Giving Day will remain in school. Parents/Guardians are to notify Form Teachers or school bus operators/external student care centre operators in advance of any changes in usual school dismissal arrangements due to the curtailed school hours.

All Lasallian primary schools in Singapore have collaborated to celebrate this day with a gift for our Lasallians. Each Lasallian will receive a tote bag with the La Salle Singapore logo as part of the Lasallian Educational Mission.



Following school dismissal, award recipients and performers who are attending Prize-Giving Day will have their recess at 10.30 a.m. Canteen stalls will be open for the purchase of food. Prize winners will join their parents/guardians for the ceremony from 12 noon to 1.30 p.m.

This year's theme for Prize-Giving Day is '***We are Lasallian***' – in celebration of the efforts and growth our Lasallians have demonstrated throughout the year and to strengthen the partnership between home and school in nurturing well-rounded individuals and lifelong learners. We would like to congratulate all prize-winners for their achievements.

5. Submission for reason of Absence via Parent's Gateway

Parents can now submit student absences through the Parents Gateway (PG) app under the "Services" tab, allowing them to select dates, provide reasons, and upload medical certificates. The app allows for advance notification and editing of submissions, with successful submissions confirmed with a checkmark. You may refer to **Annex B** for more information.

6. Travel Declaration for Mid-Year School Holidays

The mid-year school holidays will commence from 30 May to 28 June 2026. School will reopen in Term 3 on Monday, 29 June 2026. We wish all Lasallians a good mid-year break.

To ensure schools continue to be a healthy and safe environment for all, we require parents/guardians to make **a travel declaration for your child/ward only if he/she intends to travel overseas** for the holidays.

To make a travel declaration for your child/ward via Parents' Gateway (PG), go to [SERVICE > DECLARE TRAVELS].

- For travel during mid-year holiday, please declare your child/ward's travel plan(s), indicating both the country and city of travel, and any city of transit, **by Friday, 29 May 2026**. Only one parent is required to declare.

If your child/ward is **not travelling** during the holidays, **no action is required** on your side.

If there is a change of travel plan(s) after declaration, please submit a new travel declaration for the updated travel destination via PG or inform the school for cancellation of travel plan(s).

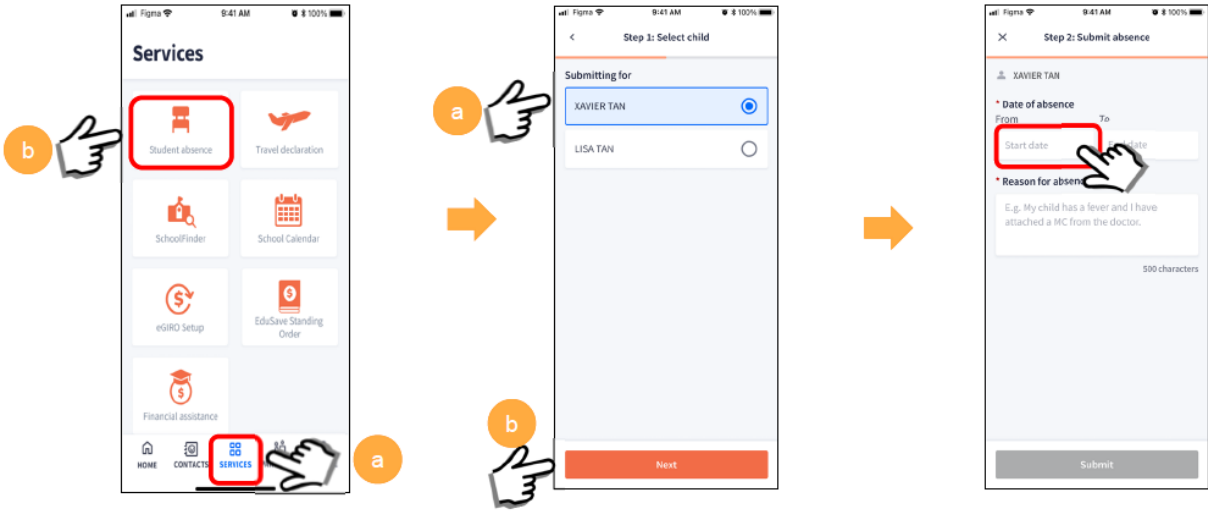

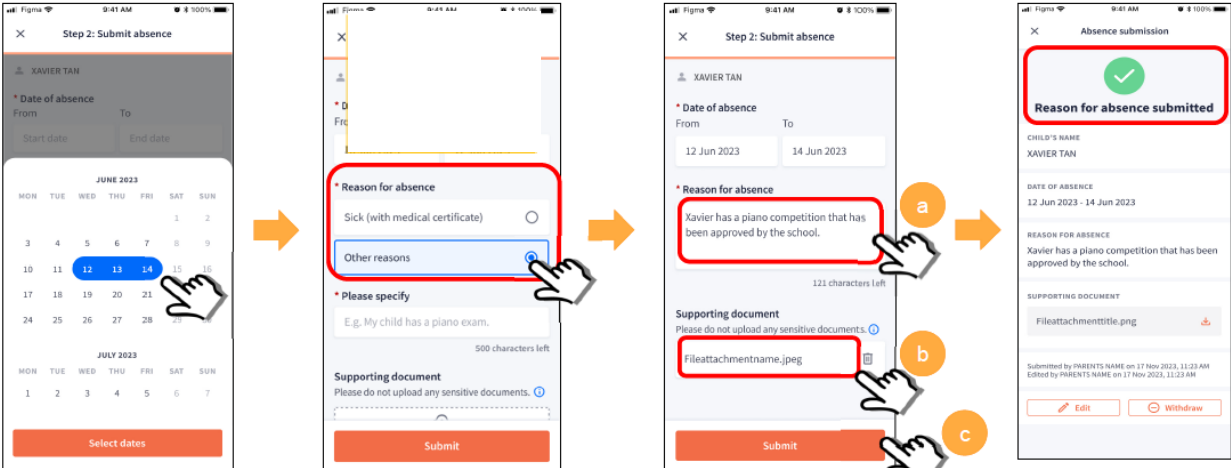

Submit child’s reason for absence



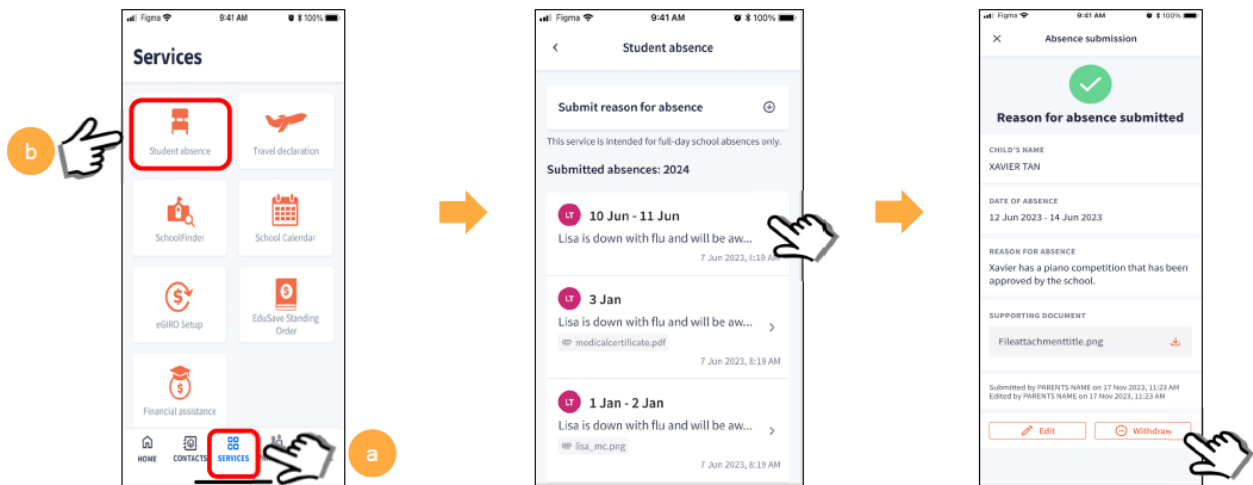
- 1. a) Go to “SERVICES” tab.
b) Click on “Student absence”
- 2. a) Select your child’s name
b) Click on “Next”
- 3. Click on box to activate calendar for selection of date.



- 4. Select the date(s) of absence.
- 5. Select reason for absence.
- 6. a) Type in reason for absence.
b) Upload medical certificate/ relevant documents¹.
c) Click on “Submit”.
- 7. You will see a  once your submission is successful.

¹ Do not upload documents that are sensitive in nature (detailed medical records, court documents, etc.)

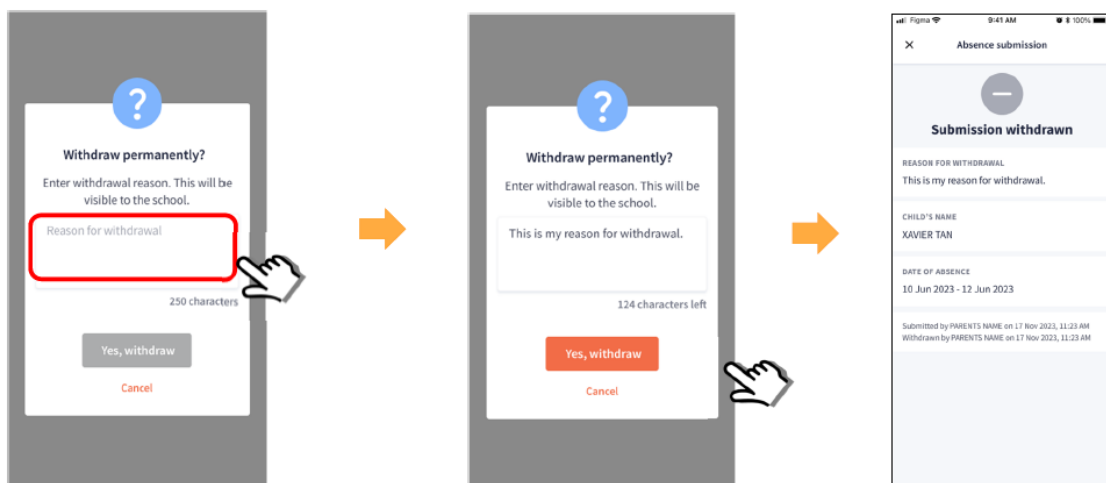
Withdrawal of submitted absence



1. a) Go to "SERVICES" tab.
b) Click on "Student absence"

2. Select the submission that you would like to withdraw.

3. Click on the withdraw button.

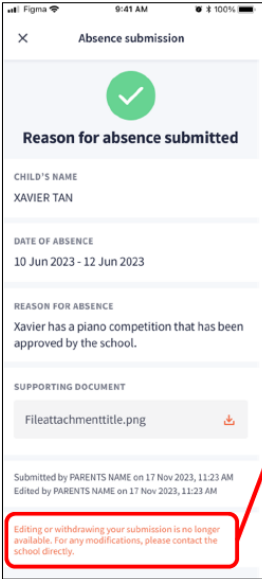


4. A pop-up screen will appear. Type reason for withdrawal.

5. Click on "Yes, withdraw".

6. Confirmation page to show submission withdrawn successfully. Teachers will be informed of the withdrawal, and they will no longer be able to see the reason submitted previously.

Expiry Date for Editing and/or Withdrawing Absence Submission



Editing or withdrawing your submission is no longer available. For any modification, please contact the school directly.

Parent will only be able to edit/withdraw absence submission within 2 weeks of submission OR within 2 weeks after absence date, whichever is later.

Example 1:
Parent submit MC on 12 Jan for absence on 12 Jan – Edit or withdrawal is permitted until 26 Jan

Example 2:
Parent submit absence on 12 Jan for 12 Sep, edit or withdrawal is permitted until 26 Sep

Example 3:
Parent submit absence on 15 Jan for 12 Jan, edit or withdrawal is permitted until 29 Jan

Note:
If teacher requests for a follow-up, there will be **no expiry date** for parents to send back and edit or withdraw.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FOR PARENTS)

Advance Submission

1. **My child has a medical appointment next month. Can I submit an absence notification in advance?**

Yes, parents may submit a notification of absence in advance through the “services” tab in the Parents Gateway App.

2. **I had made a submission in advance, but the appointment date has been changed. Can I edit my submission?**

Yes, you may click on to services tab and search for the submission that you would like to edit. You can update the details and click on submit edits.

Editing Submissions of Absence

3. **I had submitted the wrong document. What should I do?**

You may click on the ‘services’ tab, search for the wrong submission. Click into the post and search for the field “Supporting document”, Click on the delete icon and upload the correct document. Then click on submit edits.

4. **Can my spouse edit a submission that I had made?**

Your spouse can edit the submission if it is within 2 weeks of your submission.

Delayed Submission

5. **My child was absent a few weeks ago. Can I still use this service to submit the reason for my child’s absence?**

Yes, you may still submit the reason if you had not done so within the calendar year.

Withdrawal of Submission

6. **When I withdraw the submission, can the school still see what I had submitted?**

The school will be notified of the withdrawal, but they will no longer be able to see the submission or file submitted previously.

Rejection / Deletion of Submission

7. **Why did the teacher reject / delete my submission?**

The supporting documents that you have submitted are sensitive in nature (eg. detailed medical health information or court documents, etc).
