

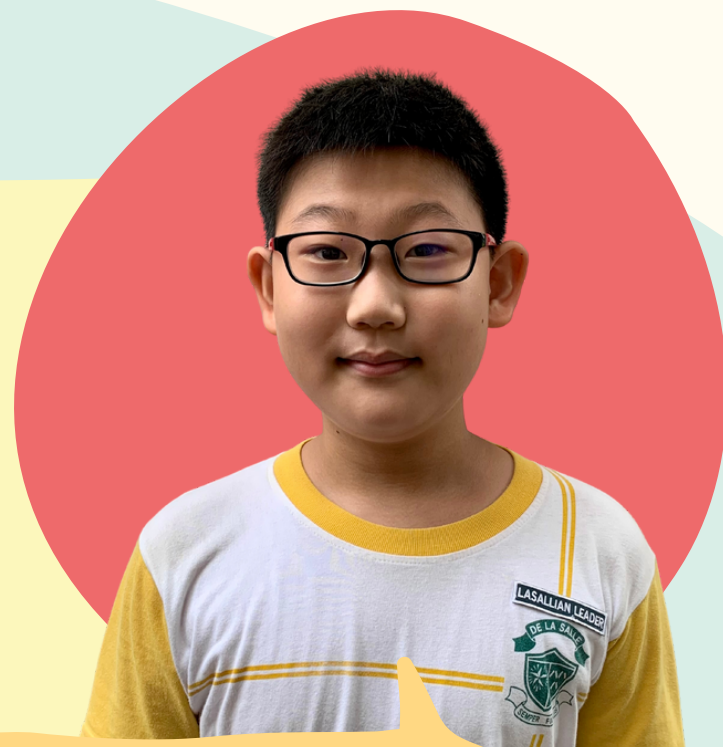
FEI YUE SENIOR ACTIVITY CENTRE

P5 LASALLIAN LEADERS



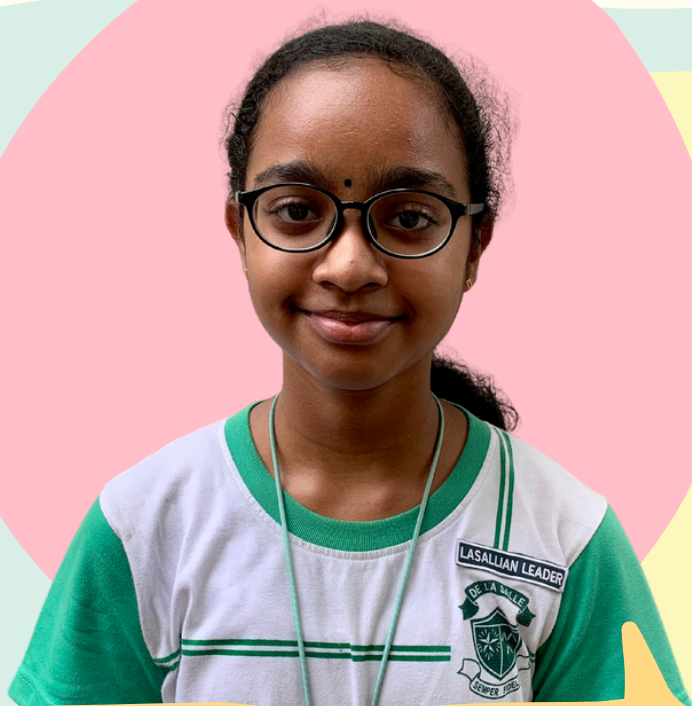
